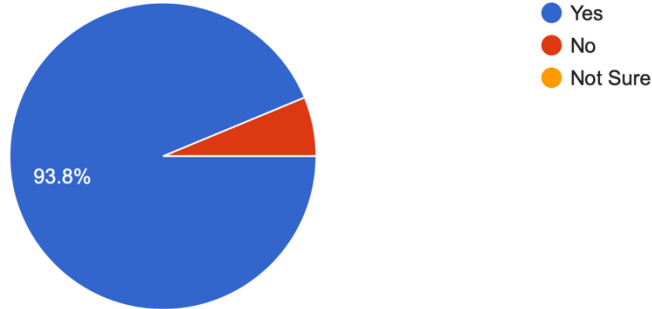


South Woodlawn Neighborhood Survey 2025 Results

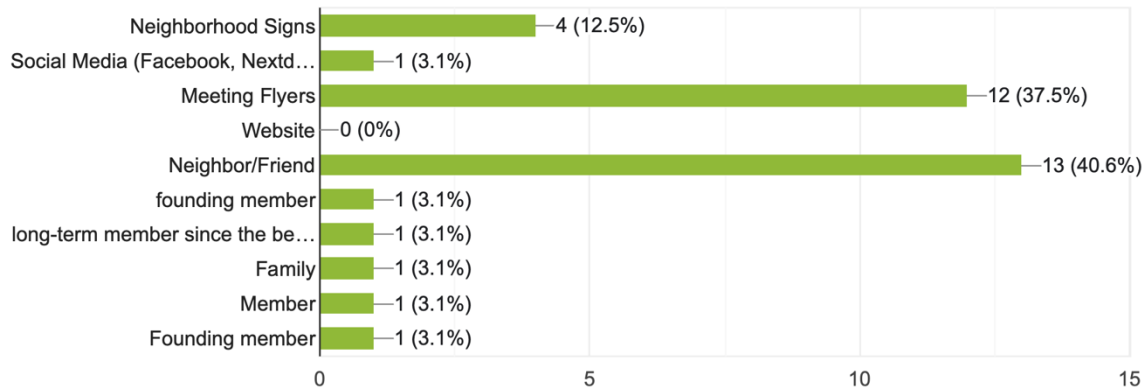
Do you live (or own a property) in the South Woodlawn Neighborhood?

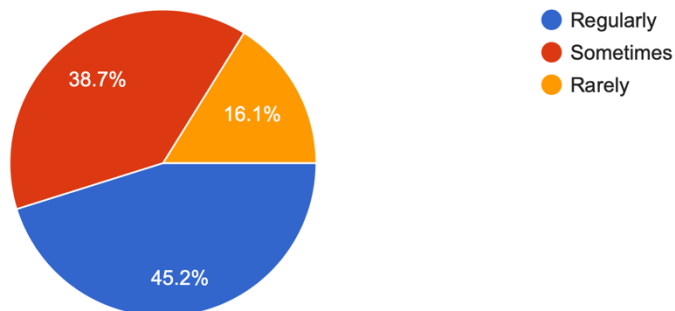
How did you learn about SWNA?

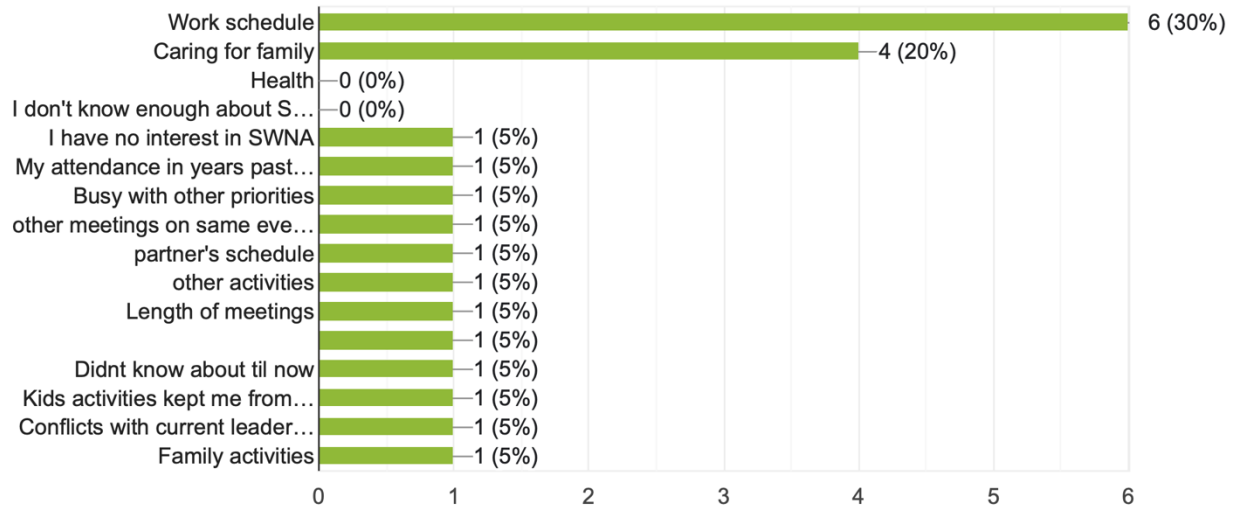
How often do you participate in SWNA meetings/activities?

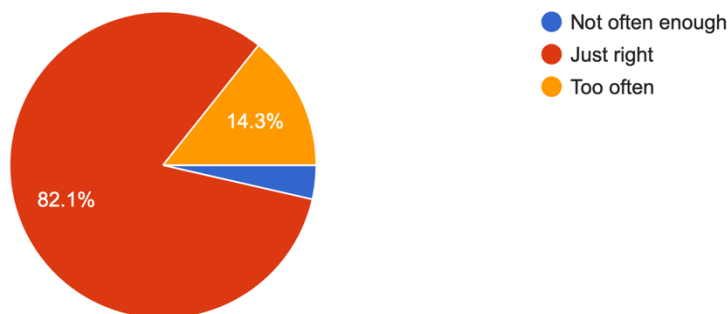

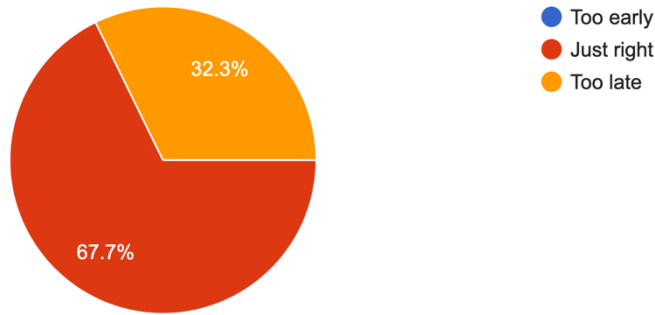


If you answered 'Not often enough' or 'Too often' above, what is your preference? 2 responses

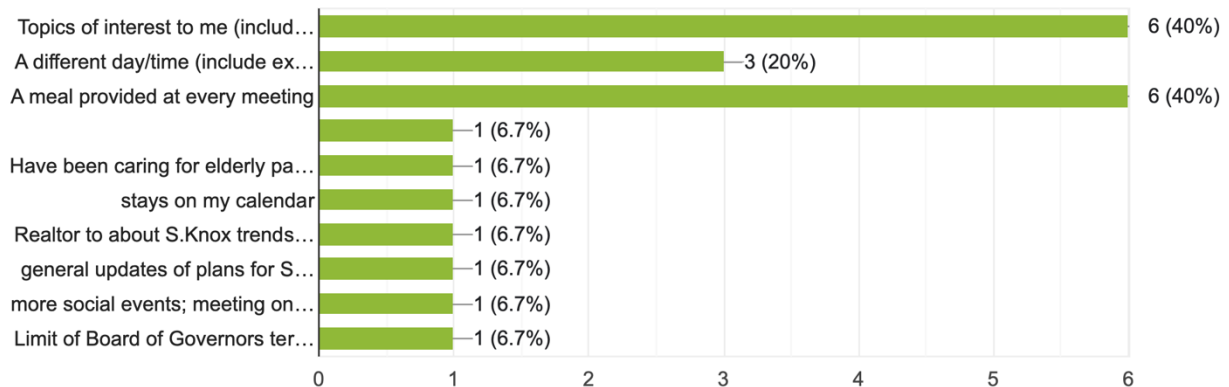


If you answered 'Too early' or 'Too late' above, what is your preference? 8 responses

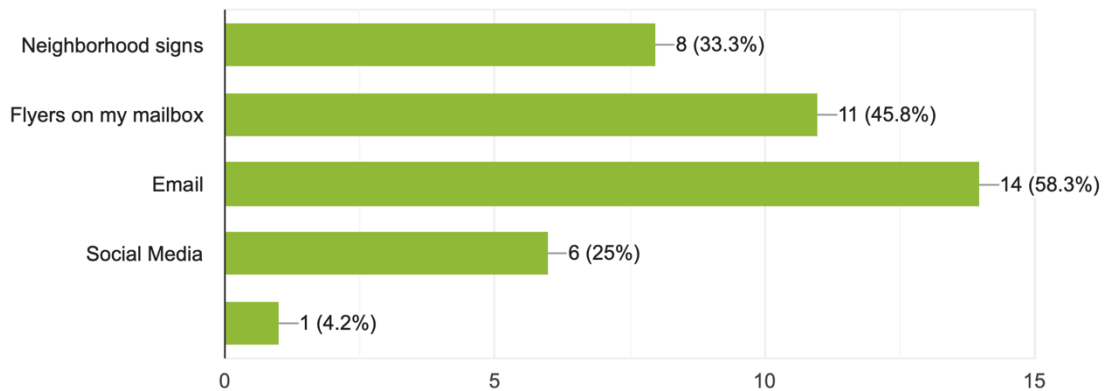

- Limit of Board of Governors terms

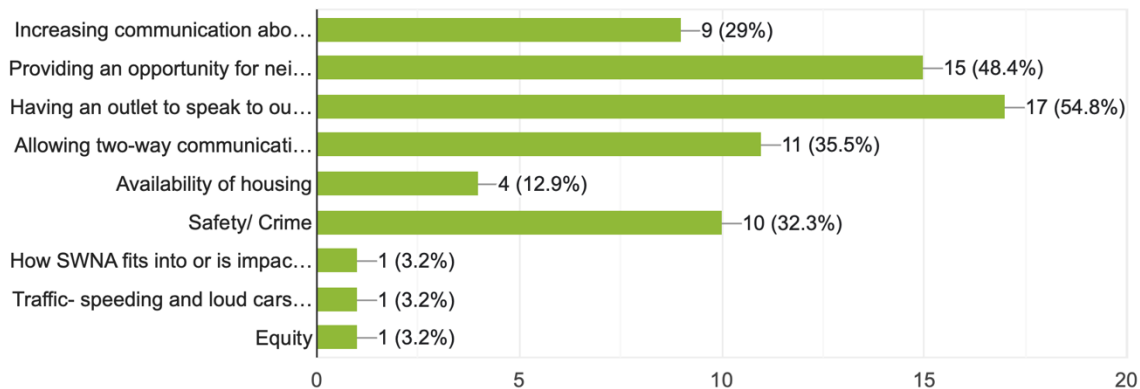
What are the best ways for you to hear about community events?
